Course Description:

Stacking rings are ideal to mix and match with your existing jewellery. On this course we will be practicing in brass or copper and then, when confident, move onto silver. We will explore various ways to texture the metal and using jewellery making techniques, which will include shaping, forming, soldering and basic stone setting, You will then learn to measure and make at least three rings. You should leave at the end of the day with a set of shiny new rings and a sound knowledge of how you made them. Suitable for beginners and more experienced makers
