Course Description:

Focusing on a range of jewellery making techniques, the workshop is designed to develop your skills, explore surface pattern and textural possibilities and encourage you to create your own silver jewellery designs. Expect to make pendants or earrings that are tactile and unique as every pass through the rolling mill is different, and every hammer blow brings exciting changes to your piece. This workshop is perfect for complete beginners and those with some experience.

Gail Coxon comes from a background in fine art and graphic design, going on to study Spatial design at the university of Salford. After the sale of a previous business she discovered the joy of metalwork and within two years had started another business selling her own jewellery. Gail is part of a local artists' collective and sells her work online, at Artisan fairs and has had worked exhibited in local galleries and museums. She began teaching wedding ring workshops and one to one sessions and now teaches classes at Heather Fox's jewellery studio.
