### **Course Description:**

Enamel is a decorative coating of coloured glass fused to metal. It is a really exciting process experimenting with coloured powder, stencils and sgraffito, then firing your own work to see how the glass melts to the copper, with jewel like results. You will create a number of jewellery pieces using this decorative process and be stunned by the variety of colours and textures you can achieve.

Initially inspired at night school and by a visit to the creative town of St. Ives, **Heather Fox** spent four years at North Wales School of Art studying for a degree in Jewellery and Metal Work. Whilst at college, she set up her own Silver Jewellery business in 2007. Heather has exhibited her jewellery in a wide range of galleries and prestigious craft fairs, as well as selling on-line. She also started to teach part time on evening classes and discovered she had a natural talent. She has her own successful studios in Warrington.
