Course Description:

Inspired by butterflies, moths and dragonflies we'll create decorative wire insects using a variety of coloured wire and beads. You'll learn how to handle different gauges of wire and experiment with stitching and wrapping techniques to create a variety of effects, adding beads for colour and texture. No previous experience needed

Judith Brown has been working with wire since 2004, mostly making silver wire jewellery but more recently working on a larger scale to create wire flowers. Her degree in Embroidery means her techniques are influenced by textiles techniques, details and textures. She sells her work through galleries, at contemporary craft events, online and through her studio in Leek, on the edge of the Peak District, where she also runs workshops.
