Course Description:

Join us for a fun and relaxing day learning the art of mosaic. Create a colourful plaque to hang outside or to decorate a wall indoors, a trivet for those hot pots on your table or brighten up coffee breaks with your own mosaic tray. You will learn about different materials and how to use mosaic tools, with lots of tips on design and pattern. Treat yourself to a great day out and take home an original mosaic of your own. No previous experience needed.

As well as creating some impressive Mosaic in her London studio, Kay has also been the lead artist on a variety of mosaic murals, both as a designer and in a teaching role. She has extensive experience teaching Art and Design, Photography and Design Technology to a wide range of age groups in Tower Hamlets, Kennington and Wandsworth as well as teaching for the Camberwell Probation Service.
