

Special Measures

We ran a successful programme in 2020, 2021 and 2022 and feedback from students and tutors was that we had implemented good safety measures and they felt safe.

- We have a fully comprehensive risk assessment in place that we review regularly.
 - The special measures we have in place, in line with Government guidelines, are reviewed regularly
 - We retain all visitors contact details to comply with the Government guidelines.
 - We have ensured a good airflow through the room, which can make the room a bit more chilly, so ask visitors to wear appropriate clothing and bring layers.
 - Floors and surfaces are disinfected between workshops
 - Hot spots such as light switches, taps and hand-rails are disinfected regularly.
 - Students are asked to use hand sanitiser as they enter the building and to wash hands regularly. Paper towel dispensers are refilled regularly
 - We do not require visitors to use Face Masks, but students are welcome to if they wish, whilst inside the art studio.
