Course Description:

The spring is a great time to comb the coast for sea glass, that's been tumbled smooth by the waves. Transform and recycle the subtle coloured pieces into jewellery that is perfect for summer. You will learn to use a range of tools and develop jewellery-making skills, working with sterling silver alongside your sea glass, to create beautiful finished pieces of jewellery.

Gail Coxon comes from a background in fine art and graphic design, going on to study Spatial design at the university of Salford. After the sale of a previous business she discovered the joy of metalwork and within two years had started another business selling her own jewellery. Gail is part of a local artists' collective and sells her work online, at Artisan fairs and has had worked exhibited in local galleries and museums. She began teaching wedding ring workshops and one to one sessions and now teaches classes at Heather Fox's jewellery studio.
